Person responsible for the bus Manual 2021

If you are the person responsible for the bus and you are prevented from meeting up on Saturday and haven't found a replacement, you should immediately ring Lisbeth 31411772.

Keys

There is no distribution of keys to the person responsible for the bus this year. It's obvious that the women's house can be used if one of the camp participants have keys and remember to close the house and gate after departure.

We'll do it this way this year because: those responsible for the economy and pub receive electronic post. And there are only exceptional circumstances where there is a need to enter the house. Luggage is primarily handled privately or by meeting up at the bus with ones belongings.

Particulars regarding Corona

The official guidelines should be followed and therefore women must wear a face mask when boarding and leaving the bus. As one has to show a Corona passport at the camp, its a good idea to encourage women to show it already on the bus as mobile coverage is much better than on the island.

Remember to register each women that has shown a current Corona passport.

Departure from the women's house

You should be at the women's house latest 09.00 AM, where the weekly participants are due to arrive 09.15. The bus leaves at 09.30.

Greet the women as they arrive and ask them to pack their things on the bus when it arrives. You could possibly encourage them to buy food or beverages for the trip in Aldi right across from the women's house. There isn't any chance for shopping in transit.

When the bus comes introduce yourself to the driver and check departure times with him (he will probably want to leave precisely 09:30 hrs).

The bus will be in front of the women's house at 09.15. If its delayed you should ring the bus company: bus rentals, Solibus. contact Per 40375030 or the driver Per 23414606.

Before you depart check that all the women and children are on board. Those on the list should be crossed off and make a note and write down those that are not on the list.

Payment for the bus is not your problem. Many of the women have already paid and the rest should pay at the camp to those responsible for the economy. You should just take care that all the women that are on the bus are also on the bus list. The bus list should be handed over to the person responsible for economy when you arrive at the camp.

If a woman hasn't shown up you can try and phone her. If she has given us her phone number it should be on the bus list. Of course it is the women's own responsibility that their luggage is on board the bus, but check anyway to be sure that everything is on board. As soon as everyone has arrived you can drive, normally 09.30 (though latest 09.40) confer with the driver.

In transit

Decide for yourself how service-minded you feel like being on the bus, but the women that are on their way to Femø for the first time will be sure to remember you if you exchange a few words with them. Ask them if they have any questions and you could possibly tell them how arrival at the camp and accommodation works.

It has already been planned with the bus company that we collect any travellers from Germany that have registered for the trip at Rødby ferry harbour. It is up to you to inform the driver if there are any women that should be collected at Rødby. It is clearly marked on the bus list.

There will be no stopping for toilet visits in transit as there are toilets on the bus. There is no longer an open toilet at Nr. Aslev station. We have sometimes used the pubs toilets, just beside the station; if you do that - please be considerate and clean up after yourself - and leave some money.

If there are many that need to use the bathroom, if may be better to find another place with more toilets as the women have to make the ferry at 14.00 hrs.

If there are any spontaneous breaks on the way it is your task to make sure that all the women are back on the bus in time.

Driving directions: I would be very surprised if this is still relevant. Please feel free to report back if this is completely nuts.

If the driver is interested you can show him these little driving directions.

- 1. Drive south on the E47 towards Rødby.
- 2. If one is going to Nr. Alslev station one should veer off at exit 43 and turn right. It is the first exit after Farø bridge (then one can drive back and end up again at the same place on the E47, or one can continue through the town and turn off at south bound road towards Nykøbing F and come out again at E47 at exit 44)
- 3. Turn off at the exit 48 (Maribo) and then turn right on the main road 9.
- 4. After a few hundred metres one should turn right at road 289.
- 5. Follow the road through Bandholm, Reernæs and Keldernæs and then turn right towards Kragnæs when you get to Birket.

Kragnæs harbour and the ferry

There is a calculated 20 minute break at Kragnæs harbour, where one can use the toilets, or buy sweets, beverages and food. Remind the women that everybody gives a hand when transporting the luggage from the bus to the pushcart and to wheel the pushcart on board the ferry. When its the jazz festival there will be reserved more places for a group of women on the ferry. Stand together and show the ferry man where you will be standing.

NB. Ferry tickets are free in July and august 2021 for passengers on foot, as I understand it.

We don't have a multi trip-ticket for the ferry. And the camp no longer pays for the ferry crossing. So the women have to pay for themselves.

Both ways 85 kr. and children 20 kr.

You may remind the women that they can join together and buy a trading card for the ferry. There is a ferry office at the dock. Presumably one can buy trading cards there.

Arrival at Cph from Femø approximately 17.00.

The communal bus arrives at Rødby ferry harbour ca.12.30 (meet up time 12.15)
