

BUS RESPONSIBLE

If you, as the bus responsible, are prevented from showing up on Saturday and have not found a replacement, you must immediately call the camp on the camp phone at 30 22 06 65.

Keys

You must contact the secretariat or Lisbeth yourself if your week needs to bring something from the women's house and needs a KEY to get in. The economics and bar responsibles receive electronic mail. And it is only in special cases that there is a need for access to the house. Transportation of material is primarily done privately or by showing up at the bus with what needs to be brought.

Departure from the Women's House

Attention – because of the new bicycle lanes, we meet at Adelgade 5-7 by Generator Hostel. Almost opposite the Women's House.

For international week, you must be at the Women's House no later than 9:00 AM. And you leave at 9:30 AM after loading the luggage.

The welcome brochure – which we usually hand out on the bus - is sent out to the individual electronically upon registration.

Greet the participants when they arrive and ask them to be ready to pack their things on the bus when it arrives around 9:10 AM. You can encourage passengers to buy drinks and food for the journey at Aldi just opposite the Women's House. There is no opportunity to shop along the way.

When the bus arrives, introduce yourself to the driver and double-check the departure time with them.

For international week, the bus should be in front of the Generator Hostel at 9:10 AM. If it is delayed, you must immediately call the bus company: Bus rental, Solibus by Per: 23414606

Before you leave, you must check if all passengers are present. Tick off those who are on the list and write down those who are not.

Checking the payment for the bus ride is not your responsibility! Most have already paid; the rest will pay to the economics responsible at the camp. You just need to make sure that all passengers on the bus are also on the bus list. So if you have additional people, please add them to the list. You hand over the bus list to the economics responsible when you arrive at the camp.

If a participant has not shown up, you can try to call them. If they have provided their phone number, it is on the bus list.



Of course, it is the passengers' own responsibility to bring all their luggage but check anyway if everything is on the bus. As soon as everyone is there, you can leave, but no later than 9:40 AM or when everyone has arrived (consult the driver if necessary).

On the Way

You decide how "service-minded" you want to be on the bus, but passengers heading to Femø for the very first time will probably remember you if you exchange a few words with them. See if they have questions and maybe tell them a bit about how the arrival at the camp and accommodation works.

This is different for international week: For all other weeks, it is pre-arranged with the bus company that passengers will be picked up in Nørre Alslev if there are passengers from Jutland, Funen, or Zealand who have signed up for the trip. On the trip to Kragenæs, the bus arrives at Nr. Alslev station *around 12:30 PM (Meeting time 12:15 PM)*.

During International week, there are no stops in Nr. Alslev. We make a pick-up in Rødby instead. Hence the earlier departure from Copenhagen.

Since there is a toilet on the bus, no pee breaks are held.

If many are in need, it might be better to find another place with more toilets, as the passengers must catch the ferry to Femø at 2 PM (meeting time at 1:30 PM, so there is time to buy a ticket).

If a spontaneous break is taken along the way, it is your task to ensure that all passengers return to the bus in time.

Driving Directions

If the driver is interested, you can show them this little driving guide:

- 1. Drive south on E47 towards Rødby.
- 2. To go to Nr. Alslev station, exit at junction 43, and turn right. It is the first exit after the Farø Bridge (then you can return and get back on E47 at the same place, or you can continue through the town and take the southbound road towards Nykøbing F, and get back on E47 at exit 44)
- 3. Exit at junction 48 (Maribo), and turn right onto main road 9.
- 4. After a few hundred meters, turn right onto road 289.
- 5. Follow the road through Bandholm, Reersnæs, and Keldernæs, and turn right towards Kragenæs when you get to Birket.

Kragenæs Harbor and the Ferry

A 30-minute break is scheduled at Kragenæs Harbor, where several can use the toilets or buy sweets, drinks, and food and you can buy the tickets.



Remind passengers that everyone helps to get the luggage from the bus onto the trolley, and to get the trolley on board the ferry.

Important- 2024

The bus passengers have already paid for the ferry and will sail on the camp's account. Bus responsibles should go to the ticket office and show the bus list with the number of adults and children written on it. You must say that you should be written ON ACCOUNT ("på konto"). It is the women's camp account – it has number 77 and you must provide the mark (password) 1971. It is very important to say ACCOUNT ("på konto") – otherwise, it is not certain that they in the ticket office can find the correct instruction.

At the Camp

When you arrive at the camp, you hand over the bus list to the economics responsible and if the bus had something from the office, you make sure it gets to the right person/place.
